JOB SUMMARY: This is a creative and technically literate leadership position overseeing the Live Production elements of Browncroft's Sunday worship experiences, as well as worship and departmental ministry events. The primary focus of this position is the weekend worship services, live video production, live lighting, and associated media technology.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Leadership

- Recruits, manages, and leads creative arts and media technology staff and volunteers.
- Provides "live video direction" and production leadership of worship services and other events, as directed by the Worship Pastor/Director.
- Organizes, develops, and trains team members and volunteers.
- Participate in the Worship and Production Leadership Team.

Live Production

- Leads and manages the technical programming and production processes for Sunday morning worship services and worship on other campus venues, with emphasis on our live video and lighting production.
- Plans, organizes, directs, and controls the live production and technical production aspects of Sunday morning worship services and other special ministry events as assigned.
- Lead, develop, recruit, and empower a team of volunteers to help execute
 the vision of our weekend experience through Live Production. This
 currently includes the leadership of volunteer live directors & producers,
 camera operators, and lighting engineers.
- Oversees the creation, management, and development of lighting and stage design.
- Leads and oversees the technical and UX development of our online live stream environments.
- Acts as a creative arts and media-tech savvy catalyst within the context of the worship service planning team under the direction of the Worship Pastor/Director and Senior Pastor.

Studio Production and Communication

 In collaboration with the Worship and Communications Teams express leadership in creating effective communication of BCC's vision, strategy, and purpose during worship services and other ministry events through the technical arts. As needed, in collaboration with the staff videographer, film, record, edit, and produce high-quality video content that furthers the vision of Browncroft.

 Accomplishes all other duties and tasks as appropriately assigned or requested.

- Bachelor's degree required in job-related field or an equivalent combination of related work experience, training and/or education sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties of the job.
- A minimum of two years of work experience, with a proven record of work accomplishment and achievement in creative arts, media tech, digital communications, and/or technically astute marketing or corporate communications is highly preferred.
- Some in depth and dedicated experience working in a Christian church or non-profit creative environment is highly preferred.

- A demonstrated ability to lead and direct staff and volunteers.
- Proficient in live video production, live streaming production.

 ProPresenter software and others as required.
- Working knowledge of Lighting and LED display systems.
- Ability to develop viable creative ideas that are relevant to BCC's vision and purposes and which effectively relate to our mission, ministries, and communications objectives.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills.
- Proven ability in areas such as live worship services or event production, and field production.
