Week Three

Philip and Nathanael

John 1:43-49
Philip tells his friend Nathanael about Jesus, and they both follow Jesus and become His friends.

Week Four

The Twelve Disciples

Matthew 4:18-22, 9:9-10, 10:2-4;
John 1:43-49
Jesus chooses 12 people from different jobs and families to follow Him and become His friends, the disciples.

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! Are you ready to follow me to the kitchen for breakfast? And we can follow Jesus by loving everyone the way Jesus loves everyone."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "Dear God, please help [child's name] and me do what Jesus says and love each other the same way Jesus loves us."



Drive Time

While on the go, point out who you are following each time you get behind a different car or person. Talk about how Jesus wants everyone to follow Him too. The way we follow Jesus is by loving each other the same way Jesus loves us.



Bath Time

Add a small scoop and some toy fish to bath time. Encourage your child to pretend they are fishing. Talk about how Jesus told four fishermen named Peter, Andrew, James, and John to follow Him, and they did!
